What? is the skating program?

The Hamilton Waterfront Trust skating lessons are a learn-to-skate program designed for beginners of all ages. The program focuses on the development of basic ice skating skills while promoting fun and participation. The Hamilton Waterfront Trust offers the citizens of Hamilton this unique opportunity to learn and participate in healthy physical activity.

The basic skills being taught include balance, forward and backward skating, stopping, turning, jumping, etc. Participants in the program have the opportunity to receive badges based on each skill they have achieved.

The Hamilton Waterfront Trust Learn-to-Skate Program will be taught by two professional coaches as well as a number of trained program assistants. We are offering our program at a cost of \$100 for the entire 10 week program (weather permitting).

All participants must wear skates, CSA approved hockey helmets and appropriate clothing for the weather conditions.

Who? can participate?

The Hamilton Waterfront Trust skating program is suitable for those just learning how to skate. Adults ages 19 and over are encouraged to join and develop basic ice skating skills in a fun and supportive environment.

When? do classes take place?

The 10 week program will take place every Wednesday evening from 6 - 7pm beginning December 7, 2011 and running until February 22, 2012 (weather permitting). Dates are as follows:

Where? are classes held?

Classes will be held at the Hamilton Waterfront outdoor ice rink on Pier 8, located at the foot of James St. North at 57 Discovery Drive (behind Williams Fresh Cafe).

How? can you participate?
